

The world is facing a global water crisis. Population growth and urbanisation, rapid industrialisation, expanding food and goods production and climate change are all putting pressure on water resources. Despite an increasing need, there is a lack of experts and businesses that can provide services in the field of sustainable sanitation and water management on an international level.

cewas is the institutional answer to this situation. It is a unique institution combining advanced education and assistance to create a Start-Up. Supported by a core group of international high-level experts (the cewas Think-Tank), cewas builds up SMEs that can offer technical and managerial expertise in the field of sustainable sanitation and water management to national and international organisations and private clients.

cewas Training Centre

Advanced education and training for cewas Start-Ups and SMEs from the Business Platform as well as external clients.



cewas Think-Tank

Coaching and support of Start-Ups. Continuos analysis of developments in the water sector and identification of key emerging issues in the water, sanitation and waste sector (business opportunities).

The cewas Start-Up Centre

In the cewas Start-Up Centre, each year, three to four groups of young entrepreneurs get the support and training they need to build up their business. The cewas Start-Up training programme includes technical and scientific aspects of sustainable sanitation and water management. In addition, training includes business basics (e.g. business planning, funding, milestone tracking, legal concerns, finance and accounting, management, marketing, presentation skills, etc.), socio-cultural and political aspects (e.g. international cooperation, intercultural communication, etc.). Start-Ups can either develop their own business idea or develop a business case identified by the cewas Think-Tank. Each Start-Up is coached by one or two Think-Tank members, high-level experts in the specific field of activity of the Start-Ups.

The cewas network formed by the Think-Tank, the cewas members and partners, clients and former cewas Start-Ups facilitates the business development process and supports Start-Ups in breaking into the emerging market. After the Start-Up phase, cewas SMEs install themselves at the cewas Business Platform, where they benefit from on-going home-base support (e.g. low office rents and shared basic facilities, backstopping by senior experts). The proximity of the different cewas SMEs and Start-Ups facilitates exploiting synergies regarding the expertise and orientation in order to provide integrated services for sustainable sanitation and water management.

You are a young (20 to 35 years old) graduate or professional from Switzerland, the EU or developing countries; you want to create your own business; you have a strong

motivation to contribute to the sustainable development of the sanitation and water sector on the national and international level; and you have "entrepreneurial spirit"?

- education and training in the field of sustainable sanitation and water management, as well as business management, financing and other complementary skills
- personal coaching by international senior experts from the water sector
- a networking platform and support to set up bridgeheads in target regions


